NOISE – During summer season, members, guests are requested to refrain from causing noise (loud radio or television playing or similar annoyance) to their neighbors and are urged to have their guests observe this request. This shall also be construed to include the barking of dogs. Major construction work or large alteration work requiring hammering and sawing shall not be permitted during the summer season (June 15th to Labor Day) or after 8:30 p.m. in the off-season except on special written approval by Board of Trustees. Painting, plumbing or other work, when not noxious or noisy, may be exempted from this rule, but under no circumstances shall work be done after 11:00 p.m. of any day.

The proposal is to change: Section #2F Article #11

Current Text (copy from Blue Book)

BALL PLAYING on beaches is prohibited between 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., unless the beach is closed to swimming. Ball playing on the roads is also prohibited.

Proposed Change

BALL PLAYING on beaches is prohibited between 11:00 am to 3:00 pm, unless the beach is closed to swimming. Games involving use of a net such as volleyball and badminton are allowed in designated areas provided for such by the Club. Playing catch with a sponge type softball is permissible. Use of a hard ball, batted ball or other hard type balls or objects is prohibited while the beach is open. Ball playing on the roads is also prohibited. Beach Security will prohibit ball playing in the event the beach is crowded. The Board of Trustees will have the right to prohibit ball playing in the event safety becomes a factor.

Intent of Change

Provide an area for young children to play.
